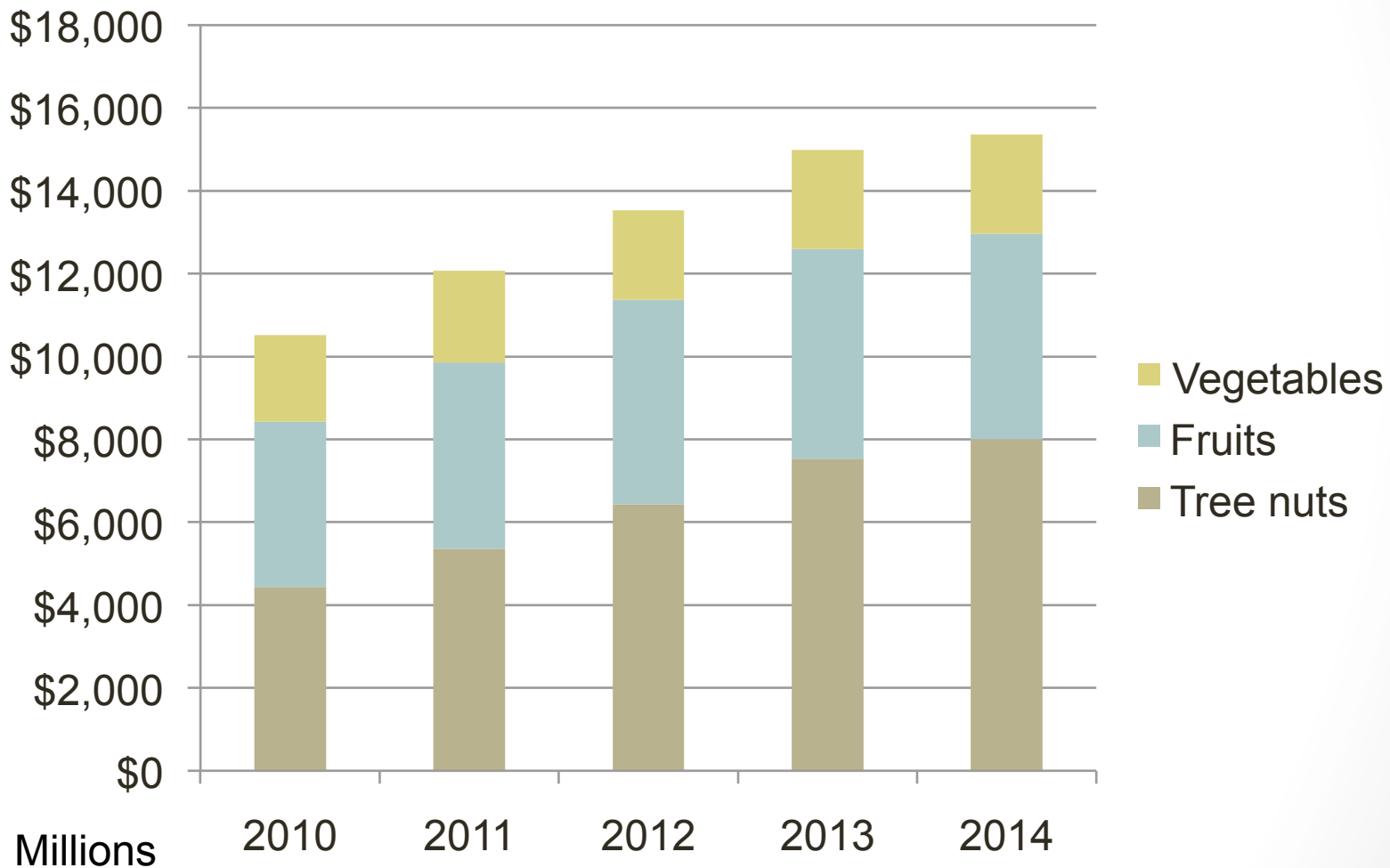

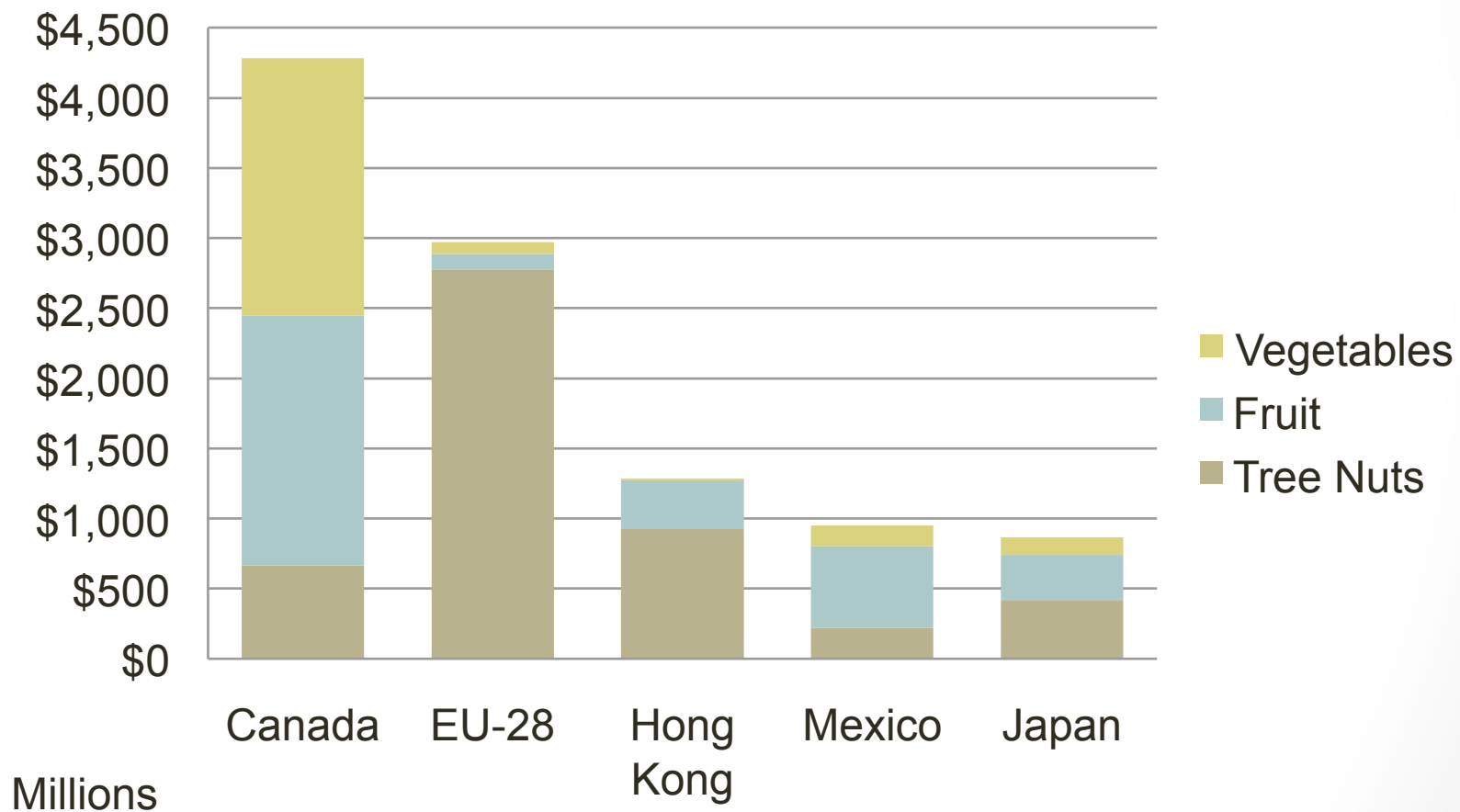

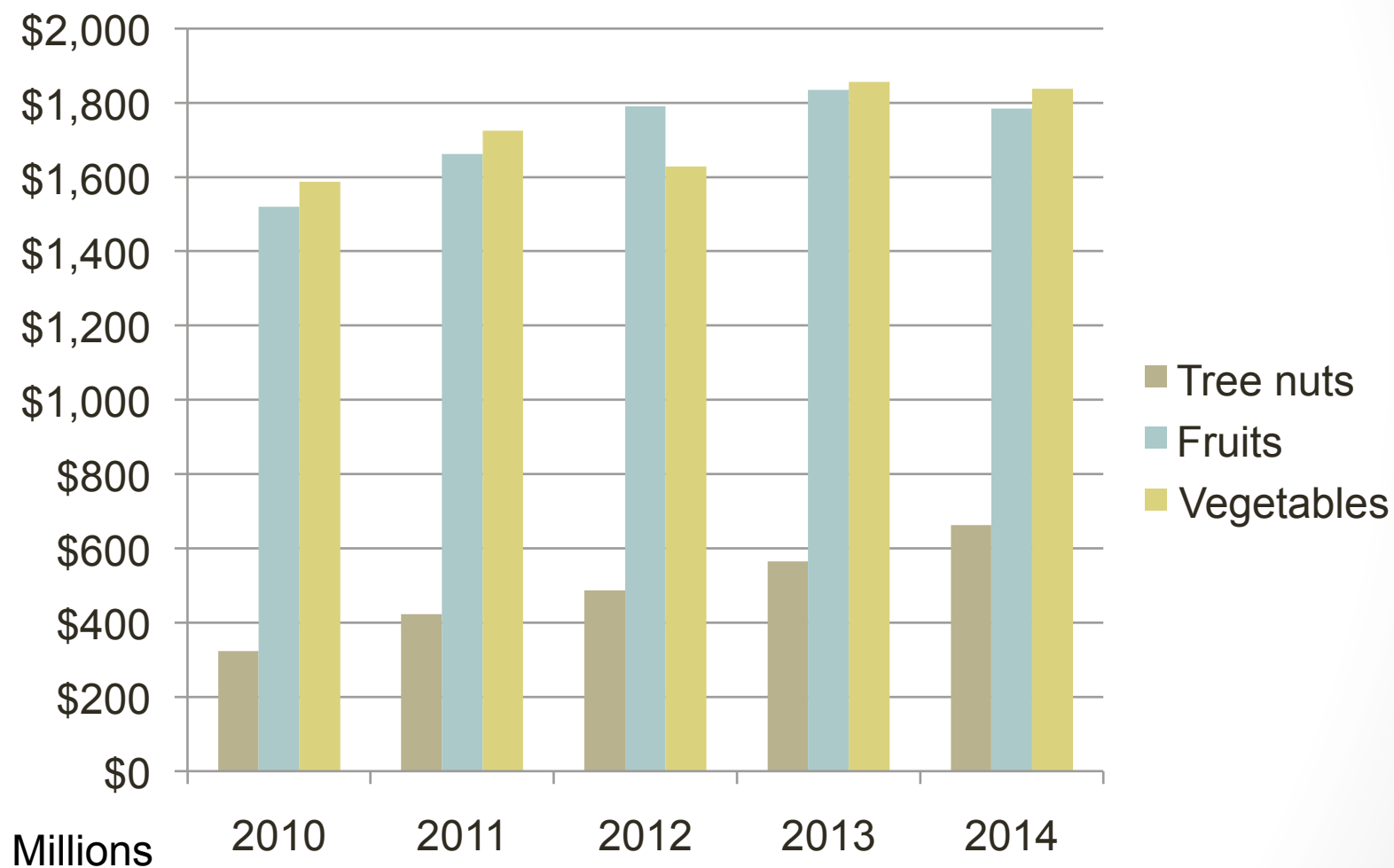


Specialty Crop's Top Markets

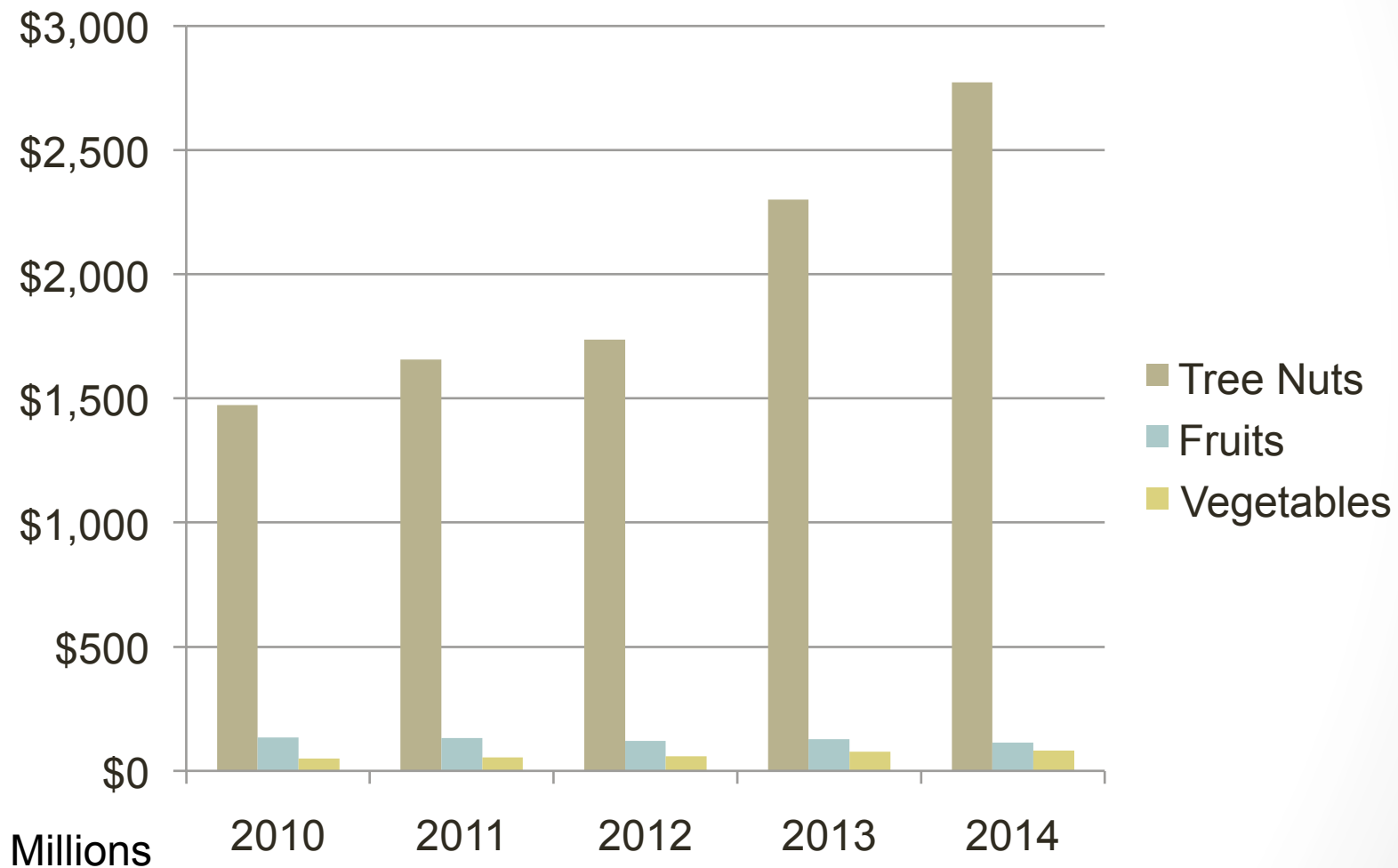

Market Development

- FAS Managed Programs



Market Access Program

- Helps finance activities to market and promote U.S. agricultural commodities and products worldwide.



Emerging Markets Program



- Provides funding for technical assistance activities to promote exports of U.S. agricultural commodities to emerging markets worldwide.

Technical Assistance for Specialty Crops

- Funds projects that address sanitary, phytosanitary and technical barriers that prohibit or threaten the export of U.S. specialty crops.



Capacity Building



- FAS provides guidance and training to governments in emerging markets to better align regulatory policies and standards.

Trade Policy

- FAS expands and maintains access to foreign markets for U.S. agricultural products by removing trade barriers and enforcing U.S. rights under existing trade agreements.
- FAS works with foreign governments, international organizations, and the interagency to establish international standards and rules to improve accountability and predictability for agricultural trade.

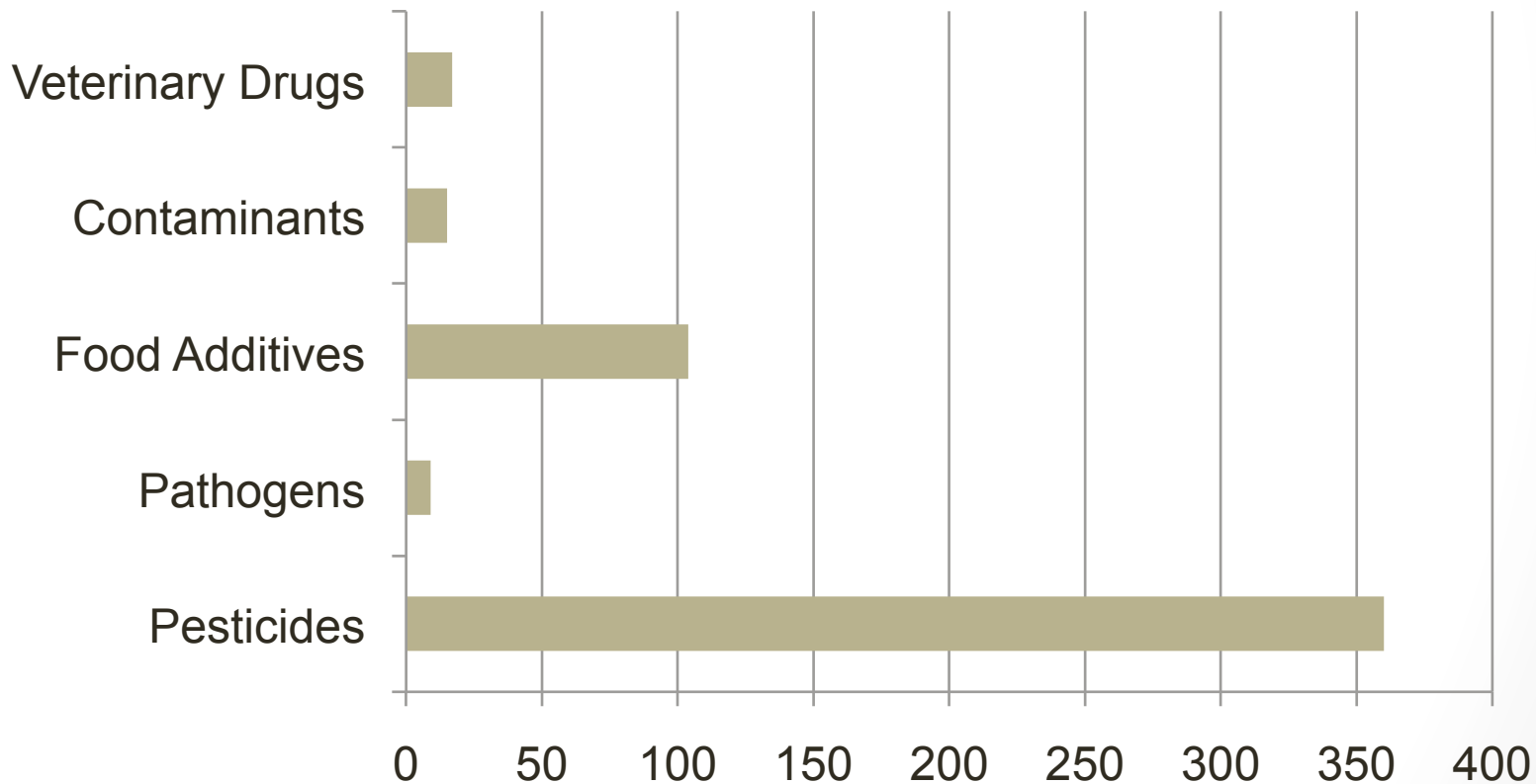
International MRLs
