

Global MRL Database at www.GlobalMRL.com

- Two types of free access (funded by USDA & EPA)
 - US-based users: US and corresponding international MRLs
 - International-based users: US MRLs
- Menu of pesticides and commodities based on those for which the US sets tolerances (40 CFR 180 Subpart C-Specific Tolerances)
- Includes import tolerances, processed commodity MRLs, veterinary drug MRLs

- Also planned
 - Additional leafy vegetable commodities in new Crop Group 4-16

 - Additional tropical and subtropical fruit commodities in new Crop Groups 23 & 24
- Countries added
 - Fiji, Ghana, Malawi, Myanmar, Nigeria, Paraguay, Senegal, Suriname, Uruguay

- Veterinary drug database upgrade underway







Codex MRL Database: Latest MRLs Not Included


- Codex maintains a database of pesticide MRLs, which does not always include the latest revisions
- Currently, the most recent MRL changes reflected in Codex's database were adopted in 2014. It does not include MRLs adopted in 2015
- Typically, new Codex MRLs are added to this database 8 months AFTER their adoption
- BCI's Global MRL Database includes the latest Codex MRLs as soon as they are adopted





Codex MRL Process: CCPR Makes Recommendations

- Each April/May, the Codex
 Committee on Pesticide Residues
 (CCPR) meets and publishes a
 report recommending MRL
 adoptions and revisions
- The report is sent to the Codex Alimentarius Commission (CAC) for review in July

Codex MRL Process: CAC Approves MRL Revisions

- Each July, the Codex Alimentarius
 Commission (CAC) meets and reviews the
 reports submitted by various committees,
 including the CCPR
- The CAC publishes a report which officially adopts some or all of the Codex MRL revisions recommended by the CCPR
- GlobalMRL.com is updated to include these new Codex MRLs immediately when the CAC report is published
