 - US-based users: US and corresponding international MRLs
 - International-based users: US MRLs

- Includes import tolerances, processed commodity MRLs, veterinary drug MRLs

 - Government websites and WTO checked each day
 - Most amendments to regulations appear in database within one business day
 - More extensive changes may take longer


